- b) If your friend walked square root of 10000 steps, how many steps did they walk?

Q3. Chocolate Sharing

You have a chocolate bar with 25 pieces arranged in a square.

- a) How many pieces are there in each row? Use square root.
- b) You ate 5 pieces. What fraction of the bar is left? Write in simplest form.

Q4. TV Time Rule

Mom says: TV time = 30 minutes times 2^3 per week "30 X 2^3 minutes per week"

- a) Solve using exponents. How many minutes total?
- b) Convert total minutes into hours.

Q5. Number Code

Think of your age. Let us say it is 13.

- a) Find out age to the power 2 using exponents.
- b) Is your answer a perfect square? What is its square root?

Q6. Money Saving

You save Rs 5 daily in your piggy bank.

- a) After 20 days, total = Rs 5 x 20 = 100. Is 100 a perfect square?
- b) If you buy a pen for Rs 20, what part of your savings did you spend? Write as a simple fraction.

Q7. Learn square and cube roots of numbers up to 30.
